- The shares were applied to the payment of withholding taxes arising in connection with the vesting of 20,769 shares on March 1, 2015. The shares that vested on March 1, 2015 include the shares that were subject to vesting on March 1, 2015 contingent upon the Company
- (1) achieving a one-year Total Stockholder Return as determined by ISS calculations for fiscal year 2014 that is greater than the average Total Stockholder Return achieved by Centene Corporation and WellCare Group for their fiscal year ending December 31, 2014. The Company's achievement of such Total Stockholder Return was certified by the compensation committee on February 24, 2015.
 - (2) Represents the opening price (and selling price) of Issuer's common stock on March 2, 2015.
- The shares vest as follows: (i) 7,007 shares shall vest upon the Company achieving total revenue in any of the 2013, 2014, or 2015 fiscal years equal to or greater than \$12 billion; (ii) 2,654 shares shall vest upon the Company achieving three-year Total Stockholder Return (TSR) as determined by ISS calculations that is greater than the median TSR achieved by the Company's ISS peer group for the three-year period ending December 31, 2016; continued
- (3) (iii) 6,635 shares shall vest upon the Company achieving a three-year EBITDA margin percentage for the three-year period ending December 31, 2016, equal to or greater than 4.0%; continued
 - (4) (iv) 6,635 shares shall vest upon the Company achieving a cumulative earnings per share of at least \$8.50 for the three year period ending
 - (5) December 31, 2016; (v) 8,740 shares vest on March 1, 2016; and (vi) 2,654 shares vest on March 1, 2017. The remainder of the shares are vested.
