Rule 10b5-1 Trading Plan

Patrick A. Immel, Vice President Information Technology Services of Computer Programs and Systems, Inc. (CPSI), has entered into a written trading plan (the Plan) relating to future sales of a part of his shares of CPSI common stock. The Plan is intended to comply with Rule 10b5-1 promulgated by the Securities and Exchange Commission pursuant to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended.
