- This exercise of stock options reported in this Form 4 relates to the Reporting Person's acquisition and sale of shares, as part of the process of exercising stock options that were scheduled to expire in July 2014. The exercise and sale were effected pursuant to a previously disclosed Rule 10b5-1 trading plan adopted by the Reporting Person on March 26, 2014.
- (1) All of the shares being sold were acquired by the Reporting Person upon the exercise of stock options. Price reflects a weighted average sale price for multiple transactions ranging from \$32.07 to \$32.28 per share, inclusive. The Reporting Person undertakes to provide, upon request by the SEC Staff, the Issuer or a security holder of the Issuer, full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price.
  - (2) These stock options, originally covering 500,000 shares, became exercisable as to 40% on May 25, 2008, 30% on May 31, 2009, and 30% on May 30, 2010.

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
