- The grant of Restricted Stock Units (RSUs) reported herein, entitles the reporting person to a reciept of shares of the issuer's common (1) stock on the later of (i) vesting of the grant or a portion thereof and (ii) such longer deferral period as the reporting person may have elected in advance.
- The Restricted Stock Units (RSUs) reported herein vest in equal installments of one-third per year on each of 3/29/07, 2/27/08, and **(2)** 2/27/09.
- As noted in footnotes 1 and 2, the Restricted Stock Units (RSUs) vest over a three-year period and, subject to any longer deferral period **(3)** selected by the reporting person, automatically convert into shares of common stock at no conversion cost to the reporting person.
- (4) Restricted Stock Units (RSUs), convert into shares of common stock on a one-for-one basis. These RSUs are issued pursuant to a provision under the issuer's Management Stock Purchase Plan (MSPP) pursuant to which directors may make an advance election to receive RSUs in lieu of a specified percentage or dollar amount of the director's annual retainer. The RSUs are issued in whole units on the basis of a 33% discount from the fair market value of the issuer's common stock on the date the underlying bonus is determined and generally vest 3 years from the date of the grant, at which time they are converted into shares of common stock unless the director has

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previously selected a longer deferral period. The reporting person has elected to receive these RSUs in lieu of his entire annual director retainer fee of \$33,500.
