- (1) Deferred Compensation Plan Participation is valued against U.S. Bancorp common stock on a one-for-one basis and is payable in common stock following the termination of the reporting person's directorship with U.S. Bancorp.
- (2) Includes additional amounts acquired after January 2007 pursuant to a dividend reinvestment feature of the U.S. Bancorp Deferred Compensation Plan.

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- (3) Restricted stock units convert into common stock on a one-for-one basis.

The restricted stock units were fully vested at the time of grant. Units are payable in common stock when the reporting person ceases to serve on the Board of Directors and is not providing services to the Company as an independent contractor, except that all units are forfeited if the holder's service is terminated for cause.

- (4) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on January 17, 2008. Units are payable in common stock when the reporting person retires in accordance with the Company's director retirement policy, the reporting person's board service is terminated without cause or the reporting person voluntarily leaves service on the Board for any reason after 10 years of service. Only vested units are distributable when the holder's Board service ends under other circumstances, except that all units are forfeited if the holder's service is terminated for cause.

- (5) Includes restricted stock units acquired after January 2007 pursuant to a dividend reinvestment feature of the reporting person's restricted stock unit award.

(6) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on January 17, 2007. Units are payable in common stock when the reporting person retires in accordance with the Company's director retirement policy, the reporting person's board service is terminated without cause or the reporting person voluntarily leaves service on the Board for any reason after 10 years of service. Only vested units are distributable when the holder's Board service ends under other circumstances, except that all units are forfeited if the holder's service is terminated for cause.

- (7) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on January 18, 2006. Units are payable in common stock when the reporting person retires in accordance with the Company's director retirement policy, the reporting person's board service is terminated without cause or the reporting person voluntarily leaves service on the Board for any reason after 10 years of service. Only vested units are distributable when the holder's Board service ends under other circumstances, except that all units are forfeited if the holder's service is terminated for cause.

- (8) The restricted stock units vest in four equal annual installments beginning on January 20, 2005. Units are payable in common stock when the reporting person retires in accordance with the Company's director retirement policy, the reporting person's board service is terminated without cause or the reporting person voluntarily leaves service on the Board for any reason after 10 years of service. Only vested units are distributable when the holder's Board service ends under other circumstances, except that all units are forfeited if the holder's service is terminated for cause.

- (9) The restricted stock units vested in four equal annual installments beginning on December 17, 2003. Units are payable in common stock when the reporting person retires in accordance with the Company's director retirement policy, the reporting person's board service is terminated without cause or the reporting person voluntarily leaves service on the Board for any reason after 10 years of service. Only vested units are distributable when the holder's Board service ends under other circumstances, except that all units are forfeited if the holder's service is terminated for cause.
