On May 22, 2007, the Registrant issued a news release to announce a cash dividend. The Registrant reported that its board of directors had declared a cash dividend of 19 cents per share payable on July 25, 2007 to shareholders of record as of June 30, 2007. The 19 cents per share dividend rate represents a 5.6% increase over the dividend rate of 18 cents per share declared in the same period of 2006.
