As Cerberus will be releasing a press release this morning, I wanted to communicate to you personally. In situations like this, it is typical to form a special committee consisting of independent directors not affiliated with Cerberus, to consider its tender offer and to make a recommendation to the Company s stockholders. We will provide further information when the BlueLinx Board makes a determination about whether to form a special committee and any recommendation made by that committee or the full Board.

There can be no assurance the proposal from Cerberus will be approved.
